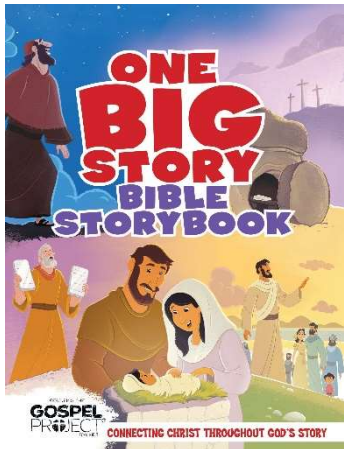

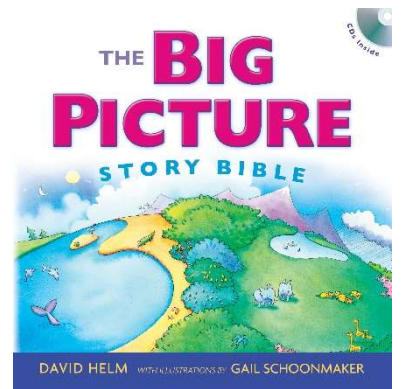
Below are resources you may want to check out ...

The Big Picture Story Bible

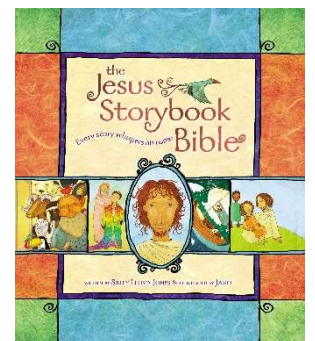


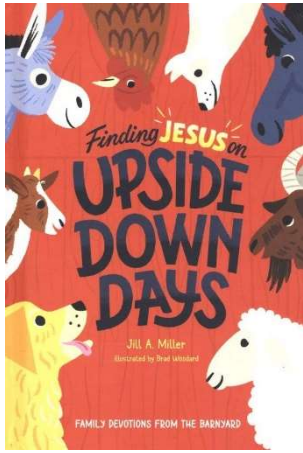
The Biggest Story

The One O'Clock Miracle... Jesus & the Lions' Den... etc.



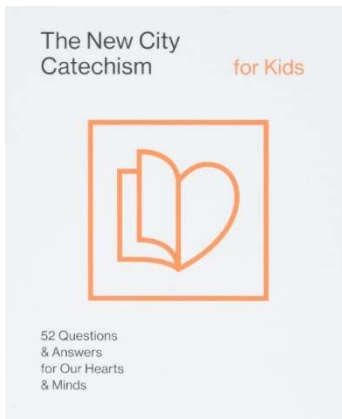
